Integrity Communications Group will not be directly or indirectly involved in the following activities:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products
- Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations
- Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations
- Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest use
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations
- Violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work

Responsibility for the Company's Chain of Custody is co-ordinated by the Environmental Manager and compliance with its requirements will be demonstrated through periodic review.
